The author is a Sambar specialist who has devoted the past 30 years of his life to studying this magnificent deer. After walking-them-up for ten years, in 1989 Errol switched from rifle to camera in his quest for a deep understanding of the habits of this elusive species, and high quality photographs and video which encapsulate it.

Eighteen years later, Errol hasn't returned to the rifle, and admits that now he could be more aptly described as a naturalist than a hunter. Errol hopes his intense desire to understand how the natural world functions comes to the fore in this volume, and helps others to derive as much quiet satisfaction from immersing themselves in nature as he does. Errol and his wife Lynne have self-published Secrets of the Sambar Vol. 1, 2 and 3, and 18 issues of their Secrets of the Sambar and Other Cervidae magazine.

They continue to run their ever popular 3 day Hunt Smart Sambar Training Course from their 220ha complex located near Omeo in Victoria's High Country. They reside near Bairnsdale at the foot of the "Great Forested Mountains" in Victoria. Australia.

It explains how to find Sambar in any weather, at any time of the day or year, and in any habitat type. Whether you hunt farm fringe, or backpack into our Great Forested Mountains, this book teaches you how to find this elusive species with comparative ease.

A reoccurring theme throughout this volume is the Sambar's somewhat systematic and predictable behaviour. In fact, it is this degree of predictability which enables tigers and leopards to successfully ambush them, without which, these predators would have even greater difficulty making a kill. No doubt this predictability made it possible for primeval man to stalk close enough to kill them with primitive weapons. It also made it possible to take the many photographs which illustrate this volume.

This volume will enable you to execute a plan during which you apply the overlays as described, thereby narrowing down where the deer are likely to be to less than 10 per cent of the forest.

When you find them they will have no idea you are there, so you have time to calm down, range the distance, take steady aim and make an instant kill. Sambar Shikar doesn't get any better than this.


